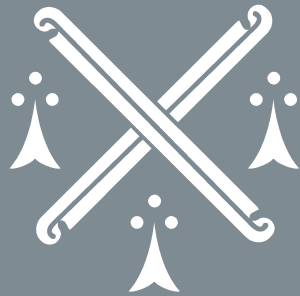

Cortese Amonte, Volpi 2023 Piemonte, Italy (Ve) <i>The Volpi family have owned and run this Tortona winery since 1914. Cortese, the grape which makes Gavi and which dates back as far as 1659, is famous for its bright lemony freshness. (12 % abv)</i>	£6.90	£25.50
QL Vinho Verde, Quinta da Lixa 2023 Lixa, Portugal <i>The Quinta da Lixa is a living testament to the passion that the Meireles family has always had for Vinho Verde. The nose is aromatic green apple, melon and white peach. The palate is white peach, apples and tangerine leading to a long, crisp finish. (10.5% abv)</i>		£27.50
Coeur du Mont Sauvignon Blanc, Vignobles Dubard 2023 Bergerac, South West France <i>The Dubard family have been making exceptional wines since the late 70's. This wine combines gooseberry, exotic fruit & peach on the nose with a rich, fresh and fruity finish. (12% abv)</i>	£8.00	£29.00
The Stump Jump Chardonnay, d'Arenberg 2022 Adelaide Hills, South Australia (Ve) <i>The name pays homage to a significant South Australian invention – The Stump Jump Plough. This ‘lightly oaked’ Chardonnay is fresh and zesty with citrus blossom, white peach and nectarine. (13.5% abv)</i>		£29.50
La Cantino Pizzolato Pinot Grigio 2023 DOC Piave, N. Italy (Ve) <i>This wonderful 5 generation organic wine from Northern Italy is citrusy, fresh and light with a bright straw yellow colour. (12% abv)</i>		£30.50
Petit Chenin, Ken Forrester Wines 2024 Stellenbosch, South Africa (Ve) <i>Ken Forrester has been producing Chenin Blanc since 1993 with top winemaker Martin Meinert. This ‘Petit’ Chenin is a perfect everyday drinking wine with quince and pear drop flavours. (13% abv)</i>	£8.50	£31.50
Riesling Trocken, Gönzheimer Weingut Eymann 2021 Pfalz, Germany (Ve) <i>Founded in 1961, the Eymann winery has been a pioneer in organic viticulture since the early 1980s. This is a handpicked Riesling from Gönheim vineyards. Spontaneously fermented in large wooden barrels and stainless steel tanks. Herbal, mineral and lean Riesling with lots of citrus and white stone fruit. (12.5% abv)</i>		£33.50
Albariño Diluvio 2023 Rias Baixas, Spain <i>Diluvio is our homage to the wet and windy weather that make Galicia the beautiful lush, green land it is. Incredible minerality, a deep straw colour without oak and a freshness of fruits and white flowers. (12.5% abv)</i>		£34.50
Mâcon-Villages Les Préludes, Vignerons des Terres Secrètes 2022 Burgundy, France <i>Nicely balanced Chardonnay from southern Burgundy, perfumed with white flowers, brimming with juicy yellow peach and finishing on a fine, refreshing mist of citrus (12.5% abv)</i>		£35.50
Picpoul de Pinet Les Prades, Caves de l'Ormarine 2023 Languedoc, France <i>Lively, fresh with lemony and floral touches followed by a light refreshing grapefruit finish. (12.5% abv)</i>		£35.50
Zibibbo DOC Sicilia, Tenute Orestiadì 2023 Sicily, Italy (Ve) <i>In a corner of Sicily where viticulture meets art, Tenute Orestiadì can be found in the heart of the Belice Valley in Gibellina. Exceptionally floral with yellow melon and peach with white flowers and lemon on the nose. (12.5% abv)</i>		£37.50
Sauvignon Blanc, Jules Taylor 2023 Marlborough, New Zealand <i>Jules loves this wine because it is so expressive of the site where it's grown. It's a grape that, within a row - and even within a bunch - has an incredible diversity of pure flavour. Vivacious tropical aromas of passionfruit burst from the glass, mixed with zingy accents of kaffir lime and subtle herbaceous notes of tomato stalk. (13.5% abv)</i>		£38.50
Grüner Veltliner, Langenlois 2022 Kamptal, Austria (Ve) <i>Cool fragrant aromas of acacia blossoms and a fine spiciness on the palate with lime and zest flavours. (12% abv)</i>		£39.50
Furleigh Estate Bacchus Fumé NV Bridport, England (Ve) <i>A family owned vineyard at the centre of the Jurassic Coast. Ripe stone fruits of peach and nectarine mingle with passionflower and lime-blossom alongside kiwifruit and exotic mandarin. A wonderful accompaniment to fish (12.5% abv)</i>		£43.50
Brokenwood Semillon 2022 Hunter Valley, Australia <i>Brokenwood was founded by a trio of Sydney-based solicitors in the foothills of the Brokenback Ranges. The original block was destined to be a cricket ground for the local community but was instead planted with vines. Lovely florals and lemongrass aromas. Mouth filling flavours of pear and lemon pith balancing the zesty acid backbone. (11% abv)</i>		£43.50
Gavi di Gavi, Ascheri 2023 Piemonte, Italy (Ve) <i>'As prestige and cooling as a white sail on the blue Med.' –Victoria Moore, The Telegraph. Notes of a floral, green fruit character with a mineral undertone. (13% abv)</i>		£44.50
Vouvray Sec, Sylvain Gaudron 2021 Loire, France <i>Very pale lemon yellow colour. Hints of honey and fresh hay typical of Chenin. Chalky minerality and a backbone of high acidity keeping the wine taut, energetic and fresh. Matured, without oak, in the bottle in the family's 13th century cellars hewn into the rock. (12% abv)</i>		£44.50
Tamboerskloof Viognier, Kleinood 2023 Western Cape, South Africa <i>The French Huguenot, Jacob de Villiers, bought the wine farm Boschendal between Stellenbosch and Franschhoek, after immigrating to the Cape of Good Hope in 1688. In the year 2000 Gerard de Villiers, a direct descendant of Jacob, and his wife, Libby, found the piece of land that stole their hearts. the name Tamboersklook means the valley (kloof) of the drums (tamboer).(13.5% abv)</i>		£45.50
Pouilly-Fume, Chateau Favray 2023 Loire, France <i>Clean, crisp Sauvignon Blanc from the grape's Loire home, this is scented with fresh grass, limestone and citrus and both stone and fruit follow the wine onto the tongue. (13% abv)</i>		£49.50
Riesling, Trimbach 2019 Alsace, France (Ve) <i>Unquestionably one of the greatest names in Alsace. It is no accident that Trimbach wines are in every one of the 3 Star Michelin restaurants in France. The acidity is so refreshing, with gorgeous grapefruit and white peach fruit. (13% abv)</i>		£52.50
Ixsir Grande Reserve White 2022 Batroun, Lebanon (Ve) <i>A lightly oaked Viognier led blend with a classy hit of vanilla and white flowers and lively flavours of peach and citrus. (13.5% abv)</i>		£56.50
Chablis 1er Cru Forêts, Domaine Louis Michel 2022 Burgundy, France (Ve) <i>The winemaker, Jean-Loup, has taken a more modern approach to fermenting, using stainless steel, with varying length of contact with the lees. This produces a fresher, crisper and more minerally finish. (13% abv)</i>		£76.50
Santorini Assyrtiko, Domaine Sigalas 2022 Santorini, Greece <i>Widely regarded as one of Greece's finest wine producers. Picked by hand, these grapes have a wonderful minerality of oyster shells and rock pools with fresh lemon citrus. (14.5% abv)</i>		£79.50

Barbera Amonte, Volpi 2023 Piemonte, Italy <i>Made with selected grapes from the Monferrato area with no contact with wood. Deliciously fruity with notes of blueberries, cherries and raspberries. Robust with a persistent finish. (13% abv)</i>	£6.90	£25.50
Crianza, Care 2021 Cariñena, Spain <i>This wonderful organic Tempranillo/Merlot blend boasts big red and black fruits with spicy aromas. Great balance of oak and fruit due to only spending 8 months in oak barrels. Label designed by local artist Enrique Torrijos. (14.5% abv)</i>	£7.75	£28.50
Bosstok Pinotage, Man Family 2022 Western Cape, South Africa (Ve) <i>A modern style of Pinotage, packed with full red berry and cranberry flavours, touches of cinnamon, toasted marshmallows and soft tannins. (13.5% abv)</i>	£8.00	£29.00
Estate Cabernet Sauvignon, De Martino 2023 Maipo, Chile <i>De Martino was the first winery to label a wine as a single varietal Carmenere and also the first winery to export Carmenere from Chile. Having won the Winery of the Year accolade on three occasions, de Martino very much sets the tone worldwide for the quality that Chilean wine can achieve. Vibrant and fresh, with lots of red fruit and cassis accompanied by notes of tobacco leaf, cedar and violets. (13% abv)</i>		£29.50
Estate Malbec, Humberto Canale 2022 Patagonia, Argentina (Ve) <i>Patagonia provides a very different wine style to those raised on the heat of Mendoza. With sunfilled days and cold nights, the High Valley of the Rio Negro gives wines strong finesse and aromatic characters. Perfect with a juicy steak! (13.5% abv)</i>		£32.50
Salice Salentino Riserva, Francesco Candido 2021 Puglia, Italy (Ve) <i>The Mediterranean climate, low rainfall and a slow ripening period, due to the striking contrast between day and night temperatures, result in the development of dried fruit flavours and a creamy bitter chocolate character. A real treat! (13.5% abv)</i>		£33.50
Primitivo IGT Puglia Organic, Varvaglione 2022 Puglia, Italy (Ve) <i>Intense Primitivo from southern Italy. Lush with blackberries and currants and elegantly perfumed with nutmeg, chocolate, liquorice and vanilla. (12.5% abv)</i>		£33.50
Plansel Selecta Reserva, Quinta da Plansel 2021 Alentejo, Portugal <i>Darkly exotic red which is heady with violets and orange blossom, followed by a mouthful of blackberries, blackcurrants and a scattering of spice. (14.5% abv)</i>		£33.50
Château Sainte Marie Bordeaux Supérieur 2022 Bordeaux, France <i>A husband and wife team, that focus on planting wine varieties in soils that bring out the best quality of their fruit. Predominantly Merlot, this wine is cracking value for money with excellent concentration of blackcurrant and plum fruit. (13.5% abv)</i>		£34.50
Côtes du Rhône, Domaine Brusset 2023 Rhône, France <i>Family run domaine in the heart of the Southern Rhône. Laurent Brusset focuses on fruit complexity to maintain a ‘sense of place’ in his wines. With subtle flavours of raspberries and other red fruits, this wine is well balanced and the tannins smooth. (13% abv)</i>		£35.50
Are You Game? Shiraz, Fowles Wine 2020 Victoria, Australia (Ve) <i>This crunchy, black fruits and cracked pepper shiraz has been cultivated in a cool climate with 10% Tempranillo. Ready to be drunk now – with or without Game! (14.5% abv)</i>		£35.50
Merlot Reserve, Pat's Garden, Ken Forrester Wines 2019 Stellenbosch, South Africa <i>Named after Ken’s mother in law, this lively South African Merlot is packed with cherries and exuding mint and a wisp of smoke. (14.5% abv)</i>		£38.50
Plumbago Nero d’Avola, Planeta 2021 Sicily, Italy (Ve) <i>An abundance of red fruits with plum aromas, ripe blackberry and scents of cocoa – typical of Western Sicily. (13.5% abv)</i>		£40.50
Gnarly Head Old Vine Zinfandel 2020, California, USA <i>Made from grapes sourced from gnarled 35-80 year old head-trained vines – some of the oldest in California. This has a core of jammy blackberry and black cherry flavors with hints of black pepper, balanced by complex oak toast. (14.5% abv)</i>		£43.50
Pinot Noir, Jules Taylor 2020 Marlborough, New Zealand <i>Grown on the southern hills in clay soils, this Pinot is well rounded with oh-so juicy flavours of cherry and black Doris plum. The wild fermentation along with extended lees maturation have added complexity and texture to the dark fruits and the finish is dry with a nice touch of dark chocolate and spice. (13.5%abv)</i>		£45.00
Ixsir Altitudes Red 2019 Batroun, Lebanon (Ve) <i>Named after the wide range of altitudes of the 110 hectares of prime calcareous marl terroir which LXSIR uses across the Lebanon between 800 and 1700 metres above sea level. Cabernet Sauvignon blend packed full of ripe strawberry fruit with cassis and a hint of green pepper (13.8% abv)</i>		£49.50
Rioja Reserva, Sierra Cantabria 2019 Rioja, Spain <i>Founded in 1957 by Guillermo Eguren, Sierra Cantabria is nestled in the heart of San Vicente de la Sonsierra, a town of great winemaking tradition. Full-bodied Rioja, packed with cherries and heady with flower petals, the whole given depth and seriousness by whiffs of tobacco, cedar and toasty oak. (14% abv)</i>		£55.50
Fleurie Poncié, Domaine du Vissoux 2022 Burgundy, France (Ve) <i>Pierre and Martine Chermette are producers of serious Beaujolais, showing what the Gamay grape is truly capable of. This wine is delicate and floral and the silky Poncié tannins give delicacy and elegance. (13.5% abv)</i>		£56.50
Gigondas Tradition Le Grand Montmirail, Domaine Brusset 2022 Rhône, France <i>With aromas of black cherry, currant & liquorice and finishing with dusty tannins, this wine is perfect for game season! (14% abv)</i>		£61.50
Chorey-les-Beaune, Domaine Maillard Père et Fils 2021 Burgandy, France <i>This young Burgundy has aromas of morello cherry and raspberries and has fine tannins with a lick of smooth woody vanilla. (13.5% abv)</i>		£66.50
Crozes-Hermitage Cuvée Albéric Bouvet Organic, Gilles Robin 2018, Rhône, France <i>This cuvee is elaborated solely with old vines from the major terroirs of the Estate (Rochas, Monico, Terres rouges). An explosion of black fruits with a good acidity, this wine has silky and round tannins. (14% abv)</i>		£70.50
Charmes de Kirwan, Margaux 2017 Bordeaux, France <i>The second wine of the famous Château Kirwan is made from the fruit of the younger vines and parcels of the vineyard. The wine is round, full and fresh, supported by a lovely tannic structure that creates an enchanting spicy finish. (12.5% abv)</i>		£81.50

Altugnac Les Turitelles Origines Rosé 2023 Languedoc-Roussillon, France <i>Located on the edge of the Languedoc, on the Pyrenean foothills, where the vines flirt with the scrubland and the woods. Around the Estate, at village level, the clay-limestone soils are covered with numerous marine fossils called turritelles. This Grenache, Syrah and Cinsault Provence style rosé displays tangy notes of citrus and turmeric. (12.5% abv)</i>	£8.00	£29.00
Tamboerskloof Katharien Rosé, Kleinood 2022 Western Cape, South Africa <i>Named after the wine makers daughter this predominantly Syrah rosé bursts full of strawberry notes and summer berries. The acidity is fresh, but the texture on palate is silky and the weight is good on the mid palate with flavours of red cherry and spice finish the wine off. (12% abv)</i>		£35.50
Rioja Rosado, Ramon Bilbao 2022 Rioja, Spain <i>Traditional Rioja Rosado, light in colour and full of flavour. With a fragrance of red berries and pomegranate topped off with aniseed and finished with raspberries, blackberries and watermelon on the palate. (12.5%)</i>		£37.50
Esprit de Gassier Rosé, Chateau Gassier 2023 Provence, France <i>Chateau Gassier is situated close to the ancient town of Aix en Provence at the foot of the Sainte Victoire mountain. Fragrant with acacia and hawthorn with exotic fruit, pear and spices on the palate.(13% abv)</i>		£40.50

Tresor Cava Brut Gran Reserva, Pere Ventura 2019 Cava, Spain (Ve) <i>Pere Ventura's great grandfather was responsible for the first cava ever made by the classical method used in Champagne. This cava of distinction has crisp apple and citrus fruits with toasty notes of nuts and oats on the nose and a palate of acacia blossom and almond. (11.5% abv)</i>	£9.00	£39.00
Brut Grande Réserve Premier Cru, Gobillard Champagne, France <i>This cuvée is made with premier cru grapes mainly from the commune of Hautvillers (where the monk, Dom Pérignon pioneered the production of Champagne), but with some blending with premier crus in Cumières and Dizy. An elegant nose redolent of citrus blossom, followed by a delicate and precise palate showing greengages and honey. (12.5% abv)</i>		£52.00

NV Brut Grande Reserve Premier Cru Half, Gobillard Champagne, France <i>This cuvée is made with premier cru grapes mainly from the commune of Hautvillers (where the monk, Dom Pérignon pioneered the production of Champagne), but with some blending with premier crus in Cumières and Dizy. An elegant nose redolent of citrus blossom, followed by a delicate and precise palate showing greengages and honey. (12.5% abv)</i>	£29.00

Riesling, Trimbach 2022 Alsace, France (Ve) <i>Unquestionably one of the greatest names in Alsace. It is no accident that Trimbach wines are in every one of the 3 Star Michelin restaurants in France. Pouilly-Fume, Chateau Favray 2023 Loire, France (Ve) <i>Clean, crisp Sauvignon Blanc from the grape's Loire home, this is scented with fresh grass, limestone and citrus and both stone and fruit follow the wine onto the tongue. (13% abv)</i>	£28.00
Crozes-Hermitage Blanc, Domaine Pochon 2023 Rhone, France <i>Etienne Pochon owns this small and certified organic estate located in Crozes Hermitage. In the medieval cellars of the Château de Curson, he vinifies his grapes plot by plot in order to keep the specificity of each terroir. Aromas of dried stone fruits and apple, with floral notes. Medium bodied with a rich texture and flavours of apple and peach. Long finish with some savoury notes. (13% abv)</i>	£35.00

Rioja Crianza Half, Ramon Bilbao 2018 Rioja, Spain <i>Rioja from a respected producer, full of black fruit plus an intriguing sour note, so that added to the sweetness of blackberries and blackcurrants comes the tang of blackberry yoghurt. (14% abv)</i>	£24.00
Graves, Château des Gravières 2022 Bordeaux, France <i>From Portets at the centre of the Graves AOC area. A Bordeaux from gravelly Graves, scented with wood and toast, then transforming into prunes and liquorice in the mouth. (13.5% abv)</i>	£24.50
Fleurie, Louis Tete 2020 Beaujolais, France (Ve) <i>From one of the Beaujolais region's loveliest villages, Fleurie, this is a gloriously ripe and perfumed wine that oozes cherry, chocolate and raspberry and finishes with a spicy flourish. (13.5% abv)</i>	£28.00
Barolo, Bovio Gianfranco 2020 Piemonte, Italy <i>Ruby red colour with brick red highlights. On the nose, fresh, with scents of dark cherries, nuts, with some subtle spice. The palate is smooth with an elegant and pure, sweet Nebbiolo fruit, very fine tannins from 18-24 months in oak barrels with a lovely savoury finish. (14.5% abv)</i>	£42.00
